

- Create Your Team, or Work Individually!** The *Making for Good Challenge* is open to individuals and teams of 2-4 students currently enrolled in 9th-12th grade. Once you decide whether to work individually or with a team, you will need to obtain parental consent and register on www.innovation-gen.com/student-challenge/about-challenge
- Review the Entry Topics.** All video entries must be aligned to one of the two entry topics: Societal Need or Environmental Need. Learn about the entry topics on: www.innovation-gen.com/student-challenge/entry-topics.

- Draw your Blueprint.** Once you/your team have settled on one idea, it is time to get to work developing the blueprint of your unique product design solution. Make sure to show us how you use the engineering design process.
- Press Record!** Record a 60-90 second video clearly explaining your unique product design solution. Don't forget, if you haven chosen to work in a team, each person in your team must have a role in the video!
